AUDITION FORM

- If you are currently experiencing symptoms of Covid-19, flu, stomach flu, stomach virus, have a cold or any other virus, if you are running a fever of 100 degrees or more, or if you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 within the past 14 days or you currently reside in a household with someone who has tested positive, please do not audition. Send an email to ptkybg@gmail.com to make arrangements for a virtual audition.

*If you are cast in the show there is an Activity Fee of \$100 that applies to anyone 18 years (non-college) and younger. As a 501c3 nonprofit we rely on investments such as these to help us produce quality events. Thank you, for understanding. Sibling discounts are available.

ILLNESS POLICY:

- At this time, mask-wearing is optional. For the overall good of the production, we reserve the right to implement mandatory mask-wearing should Covid, flu, or stomach virus numbers rise.
- Vaccinations are not mandatory, but should you do any travel by plane or spend a lot of time in large groups, we ask that you test before coming to camp or rehearsal.
- **You must have attended Kindergarten and be able to read and memorize lines to audition.**

CONFLICTS: “I can’t. I have rehearsal.” - Every actor, always. Learn these words and live by them. The show MUST be the priority. We understand that illnesses occur and emergencies arise, but the play must be rehearsed and must become the top priority on your calendar. **Rehearsals will begin no later than September 18th.** We ask that there be NO MORE THAN FOUR CONFLICTS (if these conflicts are necessary). Please provide a list of any and all conflicts that you can think of during this rehearsal period, including dance classes, ball practices, etc. With the

exception of mandatory school or work events, conflicts added after you are cast will not be permitted. **Conflicts that are not considered excused, mandatory, or emergencies - Fall festivals, school dances, concerts that do not affect grades, homecomings, birthday parties, family reunions, office parties, vacations planned after you are cast, etc.** With the exception of Thanksgiving, we ask that there be absolutely no conflicts after November 6th. **If you have a mandatory work or school event that takes place after this date, please talk to us about it.**

We will rehearse the Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of Thanksgiving week. Rehearsals, apart from an occasional Saturday rehearsal, will be held during the week (Monday through Friday) in the evening after 5.30 pm.

If you cannot attend evening rehearsals, workdays (called by the director and stage manager), BOTH TECH WEEKS, beginning on November 27th and ALL PERFORMANCES: December 7, 8, 9, and 10 and December 14, 15, 16, and 17, and School Day performances on December 12 and 13 (9 AM and 11 AM), please do not audition for this particular show.

If you have conflicts that you are not upfront about, or if this show is not made a priority, this will result in your role being recast once the rehearsal process begins.

Please DO NOT alter your appearance until you know if you are cast in the show. If you are cast in the show, PLEASE DO NOT ALTER YOUR APPEARANCE WITHOUT THE DIRECTOR'S PERMISSION. You have been cast based on your appearance at your audition and for the time period of the show. Do not cut or die your hair; get new piercings, new visible tattoos, etc. Doing so could result in your role being recast.
